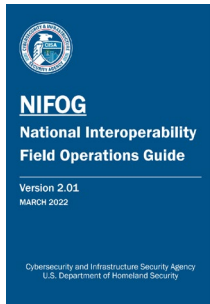




National Interoperability Field Operations Guide (NIFOG)

The National Interoperability Field Operations Guide (NIFOG) has been updated to version 2.01. New content in 2.01 includes references on Information Technology, Emergency Wireless Carrier Services, Interference Management, Encryption, and Cybersecurity. The NIFOG is a technical reference for radio technicians, used for emergency communications planning and disaster response. The NIFOG includes rules and regulations for use of nationwide and other interoperability channels, tables of frequencies and standard channel names, and other reference material, formatted as a pocket-sized guide for radio technicians to carry with them.
