The Oregon Wing Subordinate Unit Inspection (SUI) program is a crucial tool for the Oregon Wing Commander to maintain awareness of unit readiness, compliance with CAP regulations, and unit-identified best-practices for pursuing the Civil Air Patrol's missions.

As an Inspection Augmentee, you will serve on the team of subject matter experts (SMEs) that visits units and verifies compliance using nationally-developed tools and resources. You will also share the results with the SUI Team Chief and promote the vital inter-unit networking and communication that makes the Oregon Wing a better team. This experience also tends to provide valuable exposure to new ways to overcome typical obstacles and deepen team members' understanding of how the Civil Air Patrol and their individual roles function.

Required Training:

- Introduction to Inspections in the AXIS Learning Management System (**NOTE**: This can be completed before or after sharing interest in the position);
- Inspection Augmentee Qualification, which is an observed, on-the-job experience.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Senior or Master Rating in any specialty track;
- 3+ years of experience in CAP or similar organizations;
- The ability to critically consider specific requirements in CAP regulations, and apply those to the unique situations of each unit;
- Well-developed in-person and written communication skills;
- Current and graduated Unit Commanders are encouraged to apply.
