MEMORANDUM FOR ORWG OPERATIONS

SUBJECT: Flight Operations during COVID-19

- 1. Effective this date, Phase I flying is permitted with in the wing.
- 2. This includes Form 5 and Form 91 flight evaluations, dual instruction for qualification in a new aircraft, proficiency flights, and mission aircrew training. Cadet orientation flights and cadet instruction are still not authorized.
- 3. While Flying in Phase I is not mandatory, I believe it is in the best interests of mission readiness. Our members health is of the highest concern. Any aircrew member will be excused from mission training if they meet the Phase I high health risk category or they do not feel comfortable participating due to COVID-19 risk factors.
- 3. The DO will ensure that all COVID-19 ORM are reviewed and appropriate precautions put in place. Including no more than three aircrew members training together, the wear of face masks by all aircrew members, Sterilization of the aircraft and equipment after the flights. The DO may direct further restrictions and risk precautions as he deems necessary.
- 4. All other wing activities will remain in Phase 0 restrictions until I approved the wing to progress into Phase I of remobilization.
